In addition to the Dixie Day Women Tuesday AM, Tuesday PM CYOR, Thursday AM Super Stars, Thursday PM and Friday PM CYOR leagues, curlers have the opportunity to represent our club in 4 outside leagues. Below is a description of the leagues.

## Mini Majors:

This fun league allows curlers to experience and learn what is like to play each position. The league is for Leads and Seconds only who have curled for less than ten years. The games are hosted at four different clubs: Dixie, Mississauga, Oakville and Burlington. Each game, curlers play a different position. By the end of the series each curler has played in all four positions: Lead, Second, Vice and Skip.

Dixie Day Women enters two teams in this league. The Dixie convenor organizes the teams. If you are interested in playing, please contact:

## Pot-of-Gold:

This is a competitive leagued hosted by the Dixie Day Women every Wednesday morning from October to December. There are seven games per season. Four teams represent Dixie in the league. The remaining 8 teams are from Brampton, Chinguacousy, High Park, Mississauga, and Oakville. Dixie Teams are determined by the rules set out in the Outside League Rules below. (Teams have been chosen for the 22-23 season.)

## Rainbow:

This is a competitive league hosted by the Oakville Curling Club Day Women every Wednesday morning. The league begins in October and ends in December. There are seven games per season. Four teams represent Dixie in this league. The other teams are from Oakville and Mississauga.
Dixie Teams are determined by the rules set out in the Outside League Rules below. (Teams have been chosen for the 22-23 season.)

## West End:

This is a competitive league comprised of 12 teams from Dixie, Mississauga, Oakville, and High Park. A round robin is played throughout the curling season with each team hosting at least one game in the series. The league runs from October to March and the games usually take place on Monday afternoons. There are 7 games in the series and a possible $8^{\text {th }}$ tie-breaker game.

Dixie is represented by four teams chosen as detailed in the Outside League Rules detailed below. (Teams have been determined for the 22-23 season.)

Outside League Play-down Rules

(Originally Created by Town Hall agreement October, 2015)
First revision: March 29, 2017 item \#13; Second Revision: Dec. 2018 -five rock rule

OCA rules of play will apply to all games. The five rock rule will be in play. OCA rules governing late start will be applied.

These rules apply to the play-down process only. League play will be governed by league specific rules.

## Eligibility

1. Teams must have four members, declared at the cut-off date for entries.
2. Each team member must have played as a regular member of a team in at least one Day Women's series (Tuesday or Thursday am/pm or Friday CYOR) in the season of the play-down.

## Consistency

3. These same rules will apply for play-downs for all Dixie Day Women's outside leagues (Rainbow, Pot of Gold, West End).

## Automatic Entries

4. The Dixie Team which places highest in the standings for each league will be granted an automatic entry in that same league the following year. If two teams are tied in their placement in the league, they will play a game to determine which team receives the automatic entry. At least 3 team members must return the following year to claim this automatic entry.

## Format

5. Play-downs will be double knock out format with placement in the draw determined by random draw
6. The Dixie Bell Rule will apply for play-down games
7. Ties will be broken by a full end played toward the glass
8. Play-downs for West End will be held in the Spring as soon as possible after the end of league play
